
This letter confirms that Mr. Philippe Arrighi has provided French language lessons to KSH Management and staff for the past eleven years.


Dear Sir:

In verity, few teachers are acknowledged as being uniquely endowed to teach and inspire.



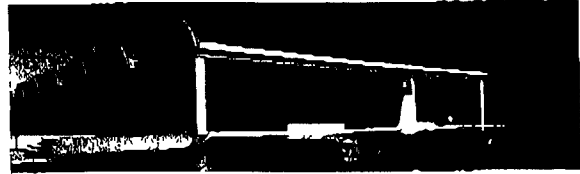
